FOUR DAY DANCE COURSE

Residential and Day students welcome
Age requirement: 9 years and above
Standard required: Grade 3 Ballet and above

The course will consist of dance classes each day and theatre workshops. Classes will include Classical Ballet and Repertoire with Pointe work (Intermediate & above) Jazz and Contemporary.

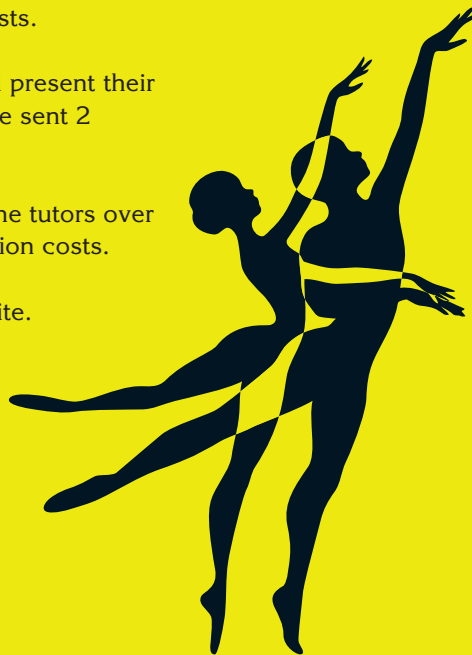
Students will be placed into groups according to age, ability and standard, and will be notified after the closing date.

Expert tuition will be provided by professional teachers, including ex members of International ballet companies. Confirmation of this years faculty and daily time table will be posted on our website as soon as possible. www.yorkshireballetscholarshipcentre.com
Ballet classes are accompanied by professional pianists.

On Thursday evening (Approx 6pm) the students will present their summer school work in a live performance and will be sent 2 theatre tickets with their acceptance letter.

We award two scholarships to students, selected by the tutors over the four days, towards next years summer school tuition costs.

RESIDENTIAL STUDENTS

Accommodation is available in Dormitories (4 beds) Twin or Single rooms. Applicants will have the opportunity to share with friends. The accommodation is furnished to a high standard including common rooms with television, dvd players and comfortable settees. Visit our website to see photographs.

Breakfast, Lunch & Tea will be provided in the hexagonal dining room with hot and cold menus and a choice of drinks. A tuck shop will be available to purchase drinks, including bottled water, snacks & sweets at breaks and in the evenings.

Evening activities will include swimming, sporting and social events, and a barbeque night with disco.

Housemothers and first aiders, who are fully licensed, will be on duty throughout. Students are not permitted to leave the campus at any time.

DAY STUDENTS
